Holy Great Martyr Procopius

**Romans 12:6-14** And having gifts differing according to the grace that is given us, let us use them: if to prophecy, let it be in proportion to our faith; or to minister, let us use it in our ministry; or to teach, in teaching; or to comfort, in comforting. In giving, let it be done with simplicity; in governing, with diligence; in showing mercy, with goodwill. Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor that which is evil; cleaving to that which is good. Be kind to one another in brotherly love, treating one another with honor. Do not falter in your diligence; remain fervent in spirit while serving the Lord. Rejoice in hope; be patient in tribulation; be steadfast in prayer. Keeping hospitality, fulfilling the needs of the saints. Bless them that persecute you; bless and do not curse.

**Matthew 9:1-8** At that time, Jesus got into a boat, crossed over and came to his own city. And behold, they brought to him a paralytic, lying on his bed; and when Jesus saw their faith he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'? But that you may know that the Son of man has authority on earth to forgive sins"--he then said to the paralytic-- "Rise, take up your bed and go home." And he rose and went home. When the crowds saw it, they marveled, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.

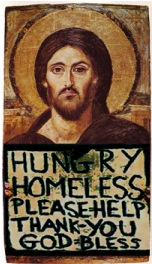
**SJM Ichetucknee
