

Martyrs Sergius and Bacchus.

**2 Cor. 11:31 – 12:9** Brethren, the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who is blessed forevermore, knoweth that I do not lie. In Damascus the governor, under Arétas the king, was guarding the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desiring to apprehend me; but I was let down in a basket through a window in the wall, and escaped his hands... It is doubtless not profitable for me to boast, but I will come to visions and revelations of the Lord: I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago [whether in the body I do not know, or whether out of the body I do not know, God knows;) such a one was caught up to the third heaven. And I know such a man; (whether in the body or out of the body I do not know, God knows;) how he was caught up into Paradise and heard inexpressible words, which are not granted for a man to utter. Of such a one I will boast; yet of myself I will not boast, except in my infirmities. For though I might desire to boast, I shall not be a fool; for I will speak the truth. But now I forbear, lest any man should think of me above that which he sees me to be, or that he hears from me. And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, a thorn in the flesh was given to me, an angel of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure. Concerning this thing I besought the Lord three times that it might depart from me. And He said unto me, "My grace is sufficient for thee, for My strength is made perfect in infirmity." Therefore most gladly I will rather boast in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may dwell in me.

**Luke 7:11 – 16** At that time, Jesus went to a city called Na'in, and many of his disciples and a great crowd went with him. As he drew near to the gate of the city, behold, a man who had died was being carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow; and a large crowd from the city was with her. And when the Lord saw her, he had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep." And he came and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still. And Jesus said, "Young man, I say to you, arise." And the dead man sat up, and began to speak. And Jesus gave him to his mother. Fear seized them all; and they glorified God, saying, "A great prophet has arisen among us!" and "God has visited his people!"
