Sunday of Zacchaeus

Hieromartyr Haralambos, Bishop of Magnesia in Thessaly, and Porphyrius, Bapthus and three women Martyrs.

1 Tim. 4:9-15 This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance. For to this end we both labor and suffer reproach, because we trust in the living God, Who is the Savior of all men, especially of those that believe. These things command and teach. Let no one despise thy youth, but be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity. Till I come, give attention to reading, to exhortation, to doctrine. Neglect not the gift that is in thee, which was given thee by prophecy with the laying on of the hands of the priesthood. Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them, that thy progress may be manifest to all...



Luke 19:1-10 At that time, Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. And there was a man named Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector, and rich. And he sought to see who Jesus was, but could not, on account of the crowd, because he was small of stature. So he ran on ahead and climbed up into a sycamore tree to see Jesus, for he was to pass that way. And when Jesus came to the place, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, make haste and come down; for I must stay at your house today." So he made haste and came down, and received him joyfully. And when they saw it they all murmured, "He has gone in to be the guest of a man who is a sinner." And Zacchaeus stood and said to the Lord, "Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have defrauded any one of anything, I restore it fourfold." And Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of man came to seek and to save the lost."

Lenten Alms Mission Commitment to Uganda

Last Sunday we heard Dn Simon Menya share about
his planned mission work in Northern Uganda. The
ministry of Lift Up Uganda run by Sue Nelson (a nurse
practitioner) sponsored Dn Simon's education at SVS. Lift Up
Uganda has also supported the building of the Northern Uganda
Medical Clinic (where our 2014 Lenten giving we supported a
medical assistant for 3 years) and St. Nektarios Nursery School
to name just a few projects.

During the Lenten Season, SJM will have a special alms
collection (alms are given in a addition to the tithe to help others in
need) to serve as seed money for Dn Simon Menya's work of
planting a self-sustaining church in Northern Uganda. We will
forward the funds to Lift Up Uganda and will be dispersed, as
appropriate, by Lift Up Uganda.

Included this Sunday in the bulletin is a card so that you can list
your commitment. It can be dropped in the basket or given to any
parish council member. If writing a check please note "Uganda"
on the memo line. All monthly mission envelopes received
between now and Pascha will go to Lift Up Uganda unless
